## The Brees Dream Foundation and Junior Achievement of North Louisiana Held the Regional Trust Your Crazy Ideas Challenge on March 10, 2021 via ZOOM!

Trust Your Crazy Ideas Challenge Continues to Inspire Young Entrepreneurs

*Shreveport, LA- March 12, 2021* – The Brees Dream Foundation and Junior Achievement of North Louisiana (JA) are thrilled to announce the results of our Virtual Trust Your Crazy Ideas Challenge Competition of 2021. 6 local teams from Caddo Magnet High School, Captain Shreve, and C.E. Bryd have completed the Idea Accelerator Workshops and brought their product from an idea to a potentially viable product. Throughout the Spring, Semi-Finalist teams attend the Idea Accelerator workshop series. At these workshops, students hear from local entrepreneurs about marketing, sales, funding, and more. Teams work with mentors from different industries to develop a pitch, a pitch deck, and a commercial for their Crazy Idea. The Idea Accelerator workshops provide a platform to not only inspire students to anticipate and solve problems, but also develop impactful and real-world entrepreneurial, management, public speaking, and networking skills that they'll need throughout their careers.

## The JA of North Louisiana Winners are:

1<sup>st</sup> Place- **Makenzie Rogers, Senior-Caddo Magnet High School**. Clean Crate, creates cosmetic beauty boxes formulated for a consumer's specific skincare needs. She **wins \$5,000** in continuing education scholarship funds and goes on to represent our area in the state competition on March 26th. In addition, **Caddo Magnet High School wins \$2,500**!

2<sup>nd</sup> Place-**Sydney Moss, Junior-C.E. Byrd High School**. Sydney created Integrity Scoring, a product idea that would solve the issue of keeping score while playing golf! Sydney was awarded **\$2,500** in continuing education scholarship funds.

3<sup>rd</sup> Place-**Kathryn Anderson, Senior-Caddo Magnet High School**. Azure Atlas is a business model that addresses the different learning styles of students and their tutoring support needs. She is the winner of **\$2,500** in continuing education scholarship funds.

The Trust Your Crazy Ideas Challenge is a partnership between Junior Achievement of North Louisiana and the Brees Dream Foundation. It is an entrepreneurial competition for high school students that have completed the JA It's My Business! program. Students are asked to come up with a crazy idea for a business and the Challenge gives them the skills to take it to the next level- *for a chance at \$10,000*! This Class is comprised of student entrepreneur teams from three Caddo Parish high schools. The winner will compete virtually against Trust Your Crazy Ideas Challenge winners from Baton Rouge, Lafayette and New Orleans during New Orleans Entrepreneurs Week 2021.

For the sixth consecutive year, The Brees Dream Foundation and JA have partnered to produce the Trust Your Crazy Ideas Challenge. This celebrated program and competition is designed to develop entrepreneurial spirit

and skills among high school students. Since 2013, the Trust Your Crazy Ideas Challenge has awarded over **\$250,000 in scholarships** to students and schools across Louisiana
