CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD







Merritt B. Chastain, Jr was born and raised in Shreveport, Louisiana. He graduated from University of Oklahoma with a BS degree. While there he was Vice President and Treasurer of his fraternity, Phi Gamma Delta. Thereafter he served as an officer in the Army Corps of Engineers, was stationed in Germany and commanded a unit which dealt with atomic weapons. After his military service Merritt attended and graduated from Paul M. Hebert Law Center at LSU where he was Vice President of the Student Bar Association.

Mr. Chastain is presently a sole law practitioner. He served as Secretary/Treasurer of the Shreveport Bar Association and President of the Young Lawyers Section thereof. He has been the King of the Krewe of Justinian, the only Mardi Gras Krewe for lawyers in the world.

Mr. Chastain is President of the Noel Foundation, Inc. which owns the Noel Collection housed at LSU in Shreveport, a priceless collection of approximately 250,000 antique books and associated materials renowned throughout the world and which gives grants to worthy non-profit institutions and scholarships to students at LSU-S, Centenary College and other local colleges totaling more than \$500,000.00 each year.

He recently served on the Board of the United Way of Northwest Louisiana and is past President of several United Way Agencies, namely, Norwela Council, Boy Scouts of America, Family Counseling and Children's Services and Volunteers of America. He has been General Chairman of the United Way campaign. He served President of the Loyola College Preparatory High School Board of Trustees, Chairman of the Loyola Educational Corporation and Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Loyola Foundation. He served as President of the Shreveport Opera, Executive Vice President of the Shreveport Symphony, President of the Cotillion Governing Board, President of the Demoiselle Club and Chairman of the Ambassadors Club. Mr. Chastain recently served on the Board of Junior Achievement of North Louisiana. He served as President of the Rotary Club of Shreveport and presently serves on the Board of Holy Angels Residential Facility and the Advisory Board of Norwela Council B.S.A.

Mr. Chastain is a lifelong member of St. Mark's Episcopal Cathedral in Shreveport and has served on the Vestry, the governing board of the cathedral.

He was chosen Outstanding Young Man of Shreveport and Outstanding Young Man of Louisiana by the Louisiana Jaycees, and was presented the Silver Beaver Award by Norwela Council, Boy Scouts of America. In addition to his regular practice of law, for many years Mr. Chastain was Managing Director and General Counsel of the National Association of Pipe Coating Applicators, an international trade association affiliated with the pipeline construction industry throughout the world. In 2003 Mr. Chastain was inducted into the Hall of Fame of that international trade association.

Mr. Chastain is married to the former Virginia Ferguson. They have two children, Merritt B. Chastain, III, who practices law in Houston, Texas and Grayson Chastain Clarke, a CPA, who lives in Shreveport and is blessed with six grandchildren.

John F. George Jr., M.D., possesses a unique combination of business development, investment management and clinical management expertise. Dr. George is President and CEO of BRF, where he leads efforts like the InterTech Science Park and EdVentures educational programs and is responsible for expansion of the organization's other economic development initiatives. These include the Entrepreneurial Accelerator Program (EAP), Envision Research, the Center for Molecular Imaging and Therapy, the Digital Media Institute at InterTech, the New Louisiana Angel Funds 1 and 2 and ownership and operation of University Health System (UHS), the region's former safety net healthcare system and clinical partner of the LSU School of Medicine in Shreveport.

Dr. George and key leadership led UHS and its 3,200 employees through a financial turnaround while increasing quality and service to underserved patients. Dr. George oversaw the preservation of UHS's \$800 million annual economic impact to North Louisiana and a \$902.5 million boost to the state's budget within the first three years of the hospitals' privatization. UHS also was able to increase contracted payments to LSU from around \$40 million to over \$100 million in a five-year period. In 2018, Dr. George and BRF leadership sold UHS and BRF initiative Future State to Ochsner Health System, the largest healthcare system in Louisiana.

In 1992, Dr. George co-founded LifeCare Management Service, LLC, a long-term acute care hospital system where he served as executive vice president. Through hospital startups and acquisitions, LifeCare owned and operated 20 hospitals in 9 states with 3,000 employees managing more than 1,200 patients per day and with annual revenues of over \$300 million. LifeCare was purchased by the Carlyle Group in 2005. Dr. George owns and operates G6 Management, a private investment and capital management firm.

It has been his life's work to promote and advocate for North Louisiana, particularly its educational institutions and economic well-being. Through BRF/EAP's entrepreneurship education initiatives and Junior Achievement programs, Dr. George has supported and helped to advance JA's mission to empower young people to own their economic success.

Dr. George and his wife, Nicole, live in Shreveport with their daughter, Angelle. He has four sons, Tripp, Graham, Crawford and Bishop.

He holds a B.S. from Centenary College of Louisiana and an M.D. from the LSU School of Medicine in Shreveport.

Among notable current and former board memberships and community contributions are the LSU Board of Supervisors, the Centenary College Board of Trustees, the Association of Governing Boards of Universities and Colleges, Barksdale Air Show, Shreveport Bossier Military Affairs Council, Barksdale Forward, Eighth Air Force Consultation Committee, and the Committee of One Hundred. Dr. George serves as board member and mentor to numerous startup companies, including Advanced Aero Concepts, Asteri Networks and Bia Energy.

Stephen F. Skrivanos is a lifelong Shreveport resident who has been involved in several professional and non-profit roles throughout his career. After graduating from Jesuit High School (now Loyola College Prep), he attended LSU Baton Rouge where he received degrees in Petroleum and Chemical Engineering in 1980.

After working for Getty Oil company for a couple of years in Mobile, Alabama, he returned to Shreveport where he worked for an independent oil and gas firm before starting Skrivanos Engineering, Inc. in 1988, which grew to operate and participate in hundreds of wells in the Gulf Coast. As an entrepreneurial investor at heart, Steve has invested in several different business ventures and remains excited about new opportunities.

Steve served as President of the Loyola College Prep Board of Trustees from 2008-10 and led its capital campaign during that period when extensive construction was done on the campus on Jordan Street. He is also the current chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Episcopal Diocese of Western Louisiana.

In 2012, Steve was the chairman of BRF when the state privatized the safety net hospitals in Shreveport and Monroe. During his tenure, the BRF acquired and operated the hospitals. He also served as the executive chairman of the newly created University Health during the entirety of its five years of operations from 2013-2018. Along with fellow JA Laureate Dr. John George and the dedicated BRF board, he fought hard to expand health care services to the underserved, preserve 3,200 jobs, and dramatically increase payments to the LSU Shreveport School of Medicine.

In 2018, Steve, Dr. George, and the entire BRF board agreed to transfer operations of the hospitals to a newly created partnership between Ochsner and LSU. Today, the hospitals and the Shreveport medical school are better and more securely funded than in any time in recent history, and their future is bright as Shreveport's Academic Medical center is now poised to attain its highest and best potential for the greater community.

More recently, Steve was asked by several members to explore the possible purchase of Southern Trace Country Club from its corporate owner to a new membership-owned group. Understanding that the failure of the membership to purchase the club would lead to declining property values and make it more difficult to recruit businesses to our area, he joined forces with other key individuals to create and structure the new membership entity and, as of July 1, 2020, the members successfully purchased the club. Steve now serves as the first president of the member-owned facility.

Steve is married to Melanie, who has roots in Austin, and he has two children, Claire and Chris. He is actively involved in the Committee of 100, Community Renewal, Inc, and several other non-profit organizations. He enjoys the piano, golf, skiing, and is an instrument rated pilot.
