- Identify and demonstrate the work-readiness skills needed to research, get and keep a job.
- Develop innovative personal strategies to pursue lifelong learning and career opportunities.

SESSION TITLES AND SUMMARIES

SESSION ONE: PERFECT MATCH

Working in groups, student identify and evaluate the 16 Success Skills and begin preparing for the JA Job Shadow site-visit.

SESSION TWO: NOW WHAT?

Individually, students prepare a resume and complete the paperwork necessary for the upcoming JA Job Shadow site-visit.

SITE-VISIT

The JA Job Shadow experience inspires students to be entrepreneurial in their approach to work by applying work-readiness skills to real-life work environments.

SESSION THREE: LOOKING BACK

Students use the work-readiness skill "Reflect and Evaluate" to complete a personal action plan.
